

The restoration includes tributes to local modern and contemporary artists of the area.
















# ERNESTINE CANON HOUSE


# SEA FLOATING HOUSE KASTELLORIZO




The restoration of a typical Dodecanese home in which the interior has been superimposed with a contemporary layer that emphasizes and is harmonious with the existing architecture: an installation of glass overlaps the existing floor, expanding the space and its natural light; a moving staircase has been added as a new element; brass tubes for the electrical system juxtapose the traditional stone casing.




## HOUSE OF A YOUNG BOURGEOIS


The interior design project sought to maintain historic elements of the original structure and add contemporary Italian touches to modernize the apartment.
